RE: PUBLIC NOTIFICATION

To Whom It May Concern:

In accordance with the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act of 1986 (AHERA), I must annually notify the public that this facility has been inspected and a management plan developed for the control of any asbestos containing material (ACM) found in this building. The Inspection Report and Management Plan was completed by a certified consulting firm - Tackett Environmental Services, Inc. (TESI) of Springboro, Ohio.

A copy of the Inspection Report and Management Plan is located in this building and also at the Xenia Board of Education for your review.

It is significant to report to you that the buildings in our district have been well- maintained in regard to the asbestos problem. Our first and foremost goal with asbestos is management control. Management procedures are in effect to control the asbestos exposure, and the cooperation of staff is most critical in the elimination of damage to the ceiling tile and pipe insulation.

All asbestos containing material should be disturbed only in accordance with the AHERA regulations.
