

What is the Educational Endowment Fund?

The Xenia Educational Endowment Fund, Inc. is separate from public funds. Income is used to support programs that assist and encourage the achievement of the highest standards of education for the young people within the Xenia school district.

Public funds available to local schools will never be adequate to provide the many significant educational opportunities that are available. The Xenia Educational Endowment Fund, Inc. provides a means of supporting some of these special opportunities, as well as providing a scholarship to a graduating senior.

All contributions are tax deductible. Investment income is used to provide grants to enrich the curriculum, improve instruction, and address other appropriate needs.

Governance of the Educational Endowment Fund

The Xenia Educational Endowment Fund, Inc. is a non-profit organization founded in 1985. It is governed by a twelve-member Board of Directors, composed of five representatives from the Xenia Area Chamber of Commerce, three representatives from the Xenia Education Association, and three representatives appointed by the Xenia Community Schools Board of Education.

Annual Reports are made available to donors upon request.



What Are The Goals of the Educational Endowment Fund?

The Goals shall include, but not be limited to, the following:

- ◆ Become the major charitable fund for those interested in improving the quality of education in Xenia schools.
- ◆ Build an additional, non-tax base of support for the Xenia schools.
- ◆ Supplement the educational needs of the district by bringing new resources for enrichment to the classroom.
- ◆ Tie the schools and the community closer together.
- ◆ Establish creative partnerships between donors and the schools.
- ◆ Provide additional assistance, support, and encouragement to both educators and students.
- ◆ Encourage an ongoing relationship between the schools and their alumni.
- ◆ Make Xenia a more attractive place for new residents and new businesses.

Past Educational Endowment Grants Awarded

The Xenia Educational Endowment Fund grants have made possible such programs in the past as:

- ♦ Project Renaissance which provides incentives for students who maintain or raise their academic achievement.
- ♦ Science Camp, which provides students with a week-long opportunity to learn more about science principles.
- ♦ Project Better Test Scores
- ♦ Inter-generational Project, which has enabled elementary school students to visit and interact with area senior citizens.

- ♦ Non-Violent Conflict Resolution program that trained students to solve their conflicts peaceably.
