Freshmen Orientation

Freshmen Orientation is scheduled for Tuesday, August 13, 2019 from 9:00am to 12:00 noon. **STUDENTS ONLY** should attend. Students will receive a draft of their class schedule. Lunch will be served after activities and orientation are concluded. Students must be picked up by 12:15pm.

Open House

The XHS Open House is scheduled for Thursday, August 15, 2019, from 4:00pm-7:30pm. All parents and students (Grades 9 through 12) are encouraged to attend.

School Fees Reminder

All students will receive an updated fee invoice at OPEN HOUSE or the first week of school. Fee balances and lunch accounts can be monitored and paid by logging onto your <u>payforit.net</u> account. Payments can also be made over the phone with credit card by calling Mrs. Daye directly at 937-562-9904 or in person by check, money order, credit card or cash at the XHS Bookkeeper's Office Monday through Friday. Checks and money orders can also be mailed to XHS (ATTN: Bookkeeper).

All school fees must be paid in full to receive credits to graduate, participate in the graduation ceremony, or to forward transcripts to a new school or college. The suggested payment schedule is as follows:

School Fees Reminder (Continued)

25% of ALL FEES paid by 10/10/19; 50% of ALL FEES paid by 12/10/19; 75% of ALL FEES paid by 3/10/20; 100% of ALL FEES should be paid in full by 5/8/20.

For the first time, there will be a fee to obtain an on-campus parking permit. This \$5.00 fee will be used to help fund the end of the year activities for all students.

Thank you in advance for making payments early and throughout the school year. If paying by cash, if possible please have the exact change. The last day to make payment by check will be Friday, May 1, 2020. Any fee related questions can be directed to Mrs. Daye, XHS Bookkeeper (937) 562-9904.

Immunization Requirement For 2019-20 Seniors

The Ohio Department of Health now requires that all students entering 12th grade have a second dose of meningococcal vaccine (MVC4) prior to the first day of the school year. If the first dose of the meningococcal vaccine was administered on or after the student's 16th birthday, a second dose is not required.

Please contact your child's physician, the Five Rivers Health Center (Xenia) (708-3400) or local pharmacies such as Walgreens (376-0631) or Walmart (376-3700) to schedule an immunization. If you have additional questions, please contact the Greene County Health Department or the Ohio Department of Health website and type "immunization" in the search engine box.

All XHS 2019-20 Grade 12 students must provide a record of this immunization (via a receipt or vaccination record) on or before August 19, 2019. Students will be excluded from attendance at school on September 9, 2019 if the immunization record has not been provided.

Chromebook Distribution

This year, Xenia High School students will be assigned a Chromebook for school use. Students will be responsible for bringing their device to school every day, and for making sure that the device is charged and ready for classroom use. We believe that it is important to integrate not only the use of technology into the educational process but also in helping students learn to maintain and handle technology responsibly; assigning devices to students is a way for Xenia High School to help teach both these important principles to our students. A school issued Chromebook and Chromebook cover is required all students attending XHS. In an effort to prepare students for the first day of classes, Chromebooks will be distributed prior to the first day of school. Chromebook distribution will take place on August 12th from 9:00am-12:00 noon and August 13th from 4:00pm-7:00pm at Xenia High School in the Main Lobby. Chromebook distribution will take approximately 25 minutes. There is a \$25.00 charge for each Chromebook and \$20.00 charge for each Chromebook cover (10th-12th grade students have the option to purchase used covers for \$10.00). Payments are due at the time of pick up. Payments can be made with cash, check, or credit card. Students are welcome (not required) to attend the distribution event, but MUST be accompanied by a guardian unless the student is 18 years of age or older.

Athletics/Fall Sports

The first home regular season football game of the year will be Thursday, August 29, 2019 at 7:00pm vs. Beavercreek. The 2019-20 homecoming game is scheduled for September 27, 2019, with the dance being held on the following evening, September 28, 2019 at 8:00pm.

The 2019-20 All-Sports passes can now be purchased in the Athletic Office. Cost of the passes are as follows: Student Pass-\$50.00; Adult Pass-\$75.00; and Family Pass-\$225.00 (up to four persons per household). Additional family members in same household may be added for \$40.00 each. Senior Citizens (62 years and older) can receive a "Senior Citizen Pass" for free admission to all Middle and High School events. All Senior Citizen Passes can be picked up at the Senior Citizen Center located at the YMCA in Xenia. Order forms are available in the XHS Main Office and the Athletic Office. Please note that All-Sports passes (including Senior Citizen Passes) DO NOT include entrance to post-season or tournament games.
