<u>Principal's Message</u> Sept, 2022

I am very excited about the upcoming 2022-23 school year. After two-plus years of COVID dominating our day to day activities, we are finally at a point where we can act without immediately worrying about whether or not our actions will make us carriers of the virus. This doesn't mean we can be carefree. The virus is still out there, and the impact on our students, our staff, and our families can still be catastrophic. But it does mean that we can start to return to what we used to call "normal" behavior again. And that should be good news for all of us.

Last year, our students started to come around to the understanding that being at the high school requires some self-discipline. <u>Immunization Requirement For 2022-</u> 23 Seniors

The Ohio Department of Health now requires that all students entering 12th grade have a second dose of meningococcal vaccine (MVC4) prior to the first day of the school year. If the first dose of the meningococcal vaccine was administered on or after the student's 16th birthday, a second dose is not required.

Please contact your child's physician, the Five Rivers Health Center (Xenia) (708-3400) or local pharmacies such as Walgreens (376-0631) or Walmart (376-3700) to schedule an immunization. If you have additional questions, please contact the Greene County Health Department or the Ohio Department of Health website and type "immunization" in the search engine box.

All XHS 2022-23 Grade 12 students must provide a record of this immunization (via a receipt or vaccination record) on or before August 17, 2022. Students will be excluded from attendance at school on September 7, 2022 if the immunization record has not been provided.

XHS Athletics

The Xenia Buccaneers fall sports season is upon us. This year all of the Xenia home athletic events will be cashless and no tickets will be sold at the gate. You must purchase your tickets prior to the game online at www.xeniaathletics.com. At the top right hand corner, click on "Ticket Spicket". Your electronic ticket can be printed out or you can save the QR code on your phone to be scanned at the gate. Nine of the ten schools in the Miami Valley League are using cashless entry beginning this fall.

2022-23 Meal Changes for XHS Students

Xenia High School students must have a Free and Reduced Priced Meals application submitted to determine eligibility for free/reduced meals for the 2022-2023 school year.

It was previously communicated to our high school families that students had up to one month to complete paperwork. This is not the case. The end of the Seamless Summer Option expansion that was in place during the pandemic means that our high school families must now complete this paperwork for the coming school year at the start of the year to see if they qualify. We apologize for the misunderstanding and any inconvenience this may have caused.

Families of XHS students who need to apply for free/reduced meals for the 2022-2023 school year should complete this process as soon as possible.

Interim Reports and Report Cards

Because guardians have access to an up-to-the minute look at their student's grades, the High School will only be generating paper interim reports for students who are failing one or more classes. And, we will only sending home a printed report card at the end of each semester. We encourage students and their guardians to take advantage of the Parent Viewer function in Progress Book, and check regularly to check student grades in all classes. If you have any questions regarding a student's progress in any of your student's classes, you can call or e-mail your student's teacher for further information. First semester report cards will be mailed home on November 10, 2022 and second semester report cards will be mailed home on June 2, 2023.



Student Drop-off and Pickup Reminder

- A reminder for all families who will be dropping off or picking up students this year. When you enter the parking lot to drop your student off, you should turn right, and proceed along the outside of the parking lot until you reach the sidewalk in front of the building. Once there, you can safely release your passengers onto the sidewalk. After your passengers have left your vehicle, you can then proceed to the end of the lot, turn left, and exit the lot.
- When you come to school to pick your student up, the same path should be taken. You should drive along the outside of the parking lot until you are in front of the building, pick up your student, and then proceed to the end of the lot, turn left, and leave through the lot exit area.
- Students should not be dropped off in the staff parking lot, the bus loading zone, or at the apartment complex behind the staff parking lot.
- We ask that you do this because it is the safest way for your student, yourself, and other drivers to drop off and pick up students. We do not want to put students or drivers at risk of an accident. So, please, for the safety of all of our families, follow this procedure. Thank you all in advance for your cooperation.

FirstView App

In partnership with First Student, the district launched the FirstView® app last spring, which allows families to track their student's bus in real time throughout the day, setting up notifications when the bus is close, as well as setting up push notifications or email messages for any alerts about your student's bus.

It is important for families to note that you must track your student by their route number, not their bus number.

FAQs About The FirstView App:

- Note that you do not need to download an app if you do not have a smartphone. The app is accessible through your browser at <u>firstsviewapp.com!</u>
- Having technical issues? Support for the app is available from FirstView by calling 888-889-8920 from 7:00am to 5:00pm (M-F), emailing their Customer Support at support@firstviewapp.com, or by using the in-app "\square" button.

Note that we will no longer use OneCall to notify families of bus changes. The FirstView app will provide the most timely information for families using their preferred method of communication (text, push notification, or email). Just be sure to set your preferences in the app!

<u>To help you in planning ahead</u> – 25% of ALL FEES should be paid by October 10, 2022; 50% of ALL FEES should be paid by December 10, 2022; 75% of ALL FEES should be paid by March 10, 2023; 100% of ALL FEES should be paid by May 5, 2023.

• Payments can be made:

- Online by credit card at www.PaySchoolsCentral.com (a nominal fee is charged);
- 2. In the XHS Bookkeeper's Office by check, money order, credit card or cash (Monday through Friday, 8:30am-3:30pm);
- 3. By mailing a check or money order payable to XHS, ATTN Bookkeeper; or
- 4. By calling Mrs. Daye at (937) 372-6983 (Ext 8098) to make payment by credit card.
- Please contact the XHS Bookkeeper's Office if you need assistance in planning your payment frequency and amounts. All payment amounts accepted no matter how small or how frequent. A receipt will be issued to you for all payments received. For example, \$3.00 per week, \$12.00 per month or \$25.00 per 9 weeks, etc. is acceptable. Please adjust payment amounts to be sufficient to completely pay balance by May 5, 2023.
- Fees follow your student year after year.
- Only current school year fees can be waived if qualified.
- Students cannot receive their grade cards, diplomas, transcripts at graduation or transfer to a new school until all fees are paid in full.
