Section 2. That the Superintendent is hereby authorized to agree in the name of the school district to be bound by all contract terms and conditions as the Department of Administrative Services, Office of Cooperative Purchasing prescribes. Such terms and conditions may include a reasonable annual membership fee to cover the administrative costs which the Department of Administrative Services incurs as a result of Xenia Community Schools participation in the contract. Further, that the Superintendent does hereby agree to be bound by all such terms and conditions and to not cause or assist in any way the misuse of such contracts or make contract disclosures to non-members of the Coop for the purpose of avoiding the requirements established by ORC 125.04.

Section 3. That the Superintendent is hereby authorized to agree in the name of the Xenia Community Schools to directly pay the vendor, under each such state contract in which it participates for items it receives pursuant to the contract, and the Superintendent does hereby agree to directly pay the vendor.
