- ➢ Mr. Soltis reminded the Board of upcoming events including the OSBA Capital Conference (November 11-14, 2017), the OSBA SW Regional Conference (October 12, 2017 at 5:00 p.m.), and an Open Meetings Act Refresher (September 27, 2017 at 6:00 p.m.) He also mentioned that he was looking forward to future discussions on options regarding the facilities. Despite knowing it will be a lengthy process, he feels he will be encouraged by the dialogue that will ensue during that process. Mr. Soltis finished by commenting on the solar eclipse that occurred that day.
